SYNOPSIS

After a shootout leaves one partner dead and another paralyzed, Chief Detective Carl Mørck is reassigned to Department Q, tasked with reviewing cold cases alongside his new assistant, Assad. Though ordered to stick to paperwork, Carl is quickly drawn into the five-year-old disappearance of politician Merete Lynggaard, last seen aboard a passenger ferry. Her brain-damaged brother was found screaming below deck, and the case was written off as a suicide. Unconvinced, Carl and Assad begin an investigation that leads them deep into the shadows of abuse and cruelty hidden beneath Scandinavia’s polished surface.



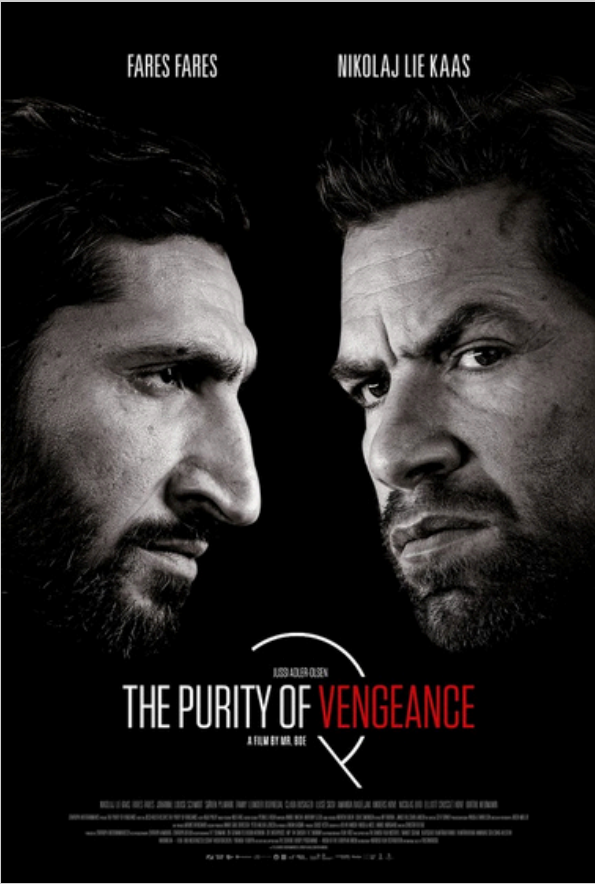
SYNOPSIS

In 1994, two twins are found brutally murdered in a summer cottage. Clues point to a group of upper-class students from a nearby boarding school, but the case is closed when a local outsider confesses and is convicted. Twenty years later, the case ends up on Carl Mørck’s desk, and he quickly senses something is wrong. As Carl and Assad investigate, they discover an old emergency call from a desperate girl who seems to know the truth. Soon, they’re searching for Kimmie, a girl who vanished after the murders. But they’re not the only ones looking for her. Powerful men will do whatever it takes to keep her silent.



SYNOPSIS

When an eight-year old message in a bottle ends up at Department Q. Carl Mørck and his assistant, Assad, are drawn into a horrific case involving a psychopathic murderer, religious fanaticism and abducted siblings never reported missing by their parents.



SYNOPSIS

In a Copenhagen apartment, craftsmen make a scary discovery: three mummified bodies seated around a dining table—with a fourth place set. Carl Mørck and Assad from Department Q must identify the victims and uncover who the missing guest is. Their investigation leads to the dark history of a women’s hospital on Sprogø Island, where forced sterilizations were once routine. As rumors suggest the abuse may still be happening, Carl and Assad start a race with time to prevent new murders and assaults.



SYNOPSIS

When 14-year-old Marco, a homeless gypsy boy, is arrested at the Danish boarder control for possession of a missing public servant's passport, police inspector Carl Mørck and his Department Q team are tasked with finding the connection. The old case contains several suspicious elements: The public servant was accused of pedophilia shortly before he disappeared, and his case was closed unusually quickly. But the silent, traumatized Marco refuses to talk to them and it's not long before he's on the run from those who intend to kill him because of what he knows.



SYNOPSIS

In a moment of cowardice, Detective Carl Mørck sends Rose, his junior colleague, to a remote Danish island to answer his old colleague Christian Habersaat’s repeated requests. But during his forced retirement ceremony Christian kills himself sending Rose into a journey into her own traumatic past. The newly engaged Carl arrives, and he, Rose and Assad becomes entangled in a cold case: a girl found dead, hanging from a tree. Officially ruled a traffic accident, the case links to the local police and a sun-worshipping cult where women have vanished for years. Carl must solve the reopened case, and confront his own dark past to move forward with his fiancée.
